**[PROPOSED] ORDER GRANTING  
CASCADE’S SECOND MOTION FOR  
LIMITED EXPEDITED DISCOVERY**

**Note On Motion Calendar:  
December 24, 2010**

THIS MATTER was noted for consideration on December 24, 2010 upon the Second Motion of Plaintiff Cascade Yarns, Inc. (“Cascade”) for Limited Expedited Discovery. Having considered Cascade’s motion and the supporting declarations of Robert A. Dunbabin, Jr., Robert J. Guite and Linda Lucente and all attachments thereto and any opposition filed by Defendants and all pleadings and files herein, it is HEREBY:

ORDERED that Cascade’s Motion for Limited Expedited Discovery is hereby GRANTED; Cascade may enter into any facilities where Knitting Fever, Inc. (“KFI”) and/or any

1 of the Defendants store yarns and select yarns from that stock for sampling and fiber analysis.  
2 Counsel for Defendants shall identify to Plaintiff's counsel all locations in the United States  
3 where KFI and/or Defendants store their yarns within two days of the date of this Order  
4 Thereafter, within five days of that date, Defendants shall permit representative(s) of Cascade  
5 entry and inspection to facilities of their choice to obtain samples of the subject yarns, including  
6 Cashmere Luxury Aran, Debbie Bliss Baby Cashmerino; KFI Cashmerino; Debbie Bliss  
7 Cashmerino Aran; Debbie Bliss Cashmerino Astrakan; Louisa Harding Kashmir Aran; Noro Cash  
8 Iroha; Noro Silk Garden; Debbie Bliss Cashmerino Superchunky; Queensland Collection Big  
9 Wave; Queensland Collection Katmandu Aran Tweed; Queensland Collection Katmandu DK  
10 Tweed; Elsebeth Lavold Silky Cashmere; Debbie Bliss Cashmerino Chunky; Elsebeth Lavold  
11 Calm Wool; Louisa Harding Kashmir Aran; Louisa Harding Kashmir DK; Louisa Harding Aimee  
12 and any other cashmere blend yarns for fiber analysis. Counsel shall cooperate in good faith to  
13 schedule those inspection(s) at mutually agreeable times. A representative of the Defendants  
14 and/or their counsel may accompany Cascade's representative(s) during the selection of samples  
15 and make record of those yarns selected. Plaintiff shall pay the list wholesale price for any yarns  
16 selected for fiber analysis within 10 days of an invoice submitted by Defendants' counsel to  
17 counsel for Plaintiff.
