



**Diane's Baseball Jacket (B102)
Using Cascade Magnum Pattern**



Diane's Baseball Jacket (B102)

Designed by Diane Carlson

Materials: Cascade Magnum, 5,6 hanks for plain.
6,7 hanks total for multicolored version. 5 colors
(2,3 of main (A), 1 each of contrast colors (B, C, D, E)
The model was done with 4007 as the main and 4009, 4008, 4006 & 0075.
6/7 1" buttons suitable for chunky projects.

Needles: 15 & 17

Size: Medium (40"), Large (44") Instructions for larger size are in **bold**.

Gauge: 2 sts = 1" on #17 needles st st.

Back:

With #15 needle & A CO 40/44 sts. Work in K1, P1 rib for 7 rows. Change to #17 needle.

Row 1: Knit 21/24 sts A, knit 19/20 sts B.

Row 2: Purl 19/20 sts B, purl 2/4 sts A, purl 19/20 sts C.

Row 3: Knit 18/19 sts B, knit 4/6 sts A, knit 18/19 sts C.

Continue working in st st, increasing the middle section of A by 2 sts on every knit row until the B & C sections are down to 2 st. (Work the rest of piece in A on at that point.) Work until the piece measures 13"/15".

Armhole shaping: BO 2/3 sts next 2 rows then dec 1 st on next 2 rows (34/36 sts).

Continue in st st until armhole measures 10", 11". Place 11/12 sts on holder for shoulder, 12 sts for neck, & 11/12 sts for second shoulder.

Left Front:

With #15 needle & A CO 24/26 sts. Work in K1, P1 rib for 7 rows. Change to #17 needle.

Row 1: Knit 20/22 st st in A, moss stitch 4 sts in A.

Row 2: moss stitch 4 in A, k14/16 in A, k6 in B.

Row 3: k6 in B and place rest of stitches on holder. Working with B, CO 10/11 more sts for body of pocket. Work in st st until piece measures 7". Put stitches on holder.

Place stitches of A back on needle. Work 3 sts in D, 15/17 sts in A (11/13 st st & 4 moss st of edge). Work until piece measures 7".

Next Row: k6 st of pocket facing, then knit together the remaining pocket lining stitches with stitches of front body.

Work 2 rows as established with 6 stitches of B at the side seam. Then decrease 1 st of B at side EOR down to 4 sts.

Work until piece is 13"/15" and shape armhole as for back. When armhole measures 7"/8" work neck shaping.

Neck shaping: BO 4 sts at neck edge twice, 3 sts once (BO 4 sts at neck edge once, 3 st twice). Work until piece is same length as back. Knit tog these sts with the corresponding shoulder sts from the back.

Right Front: Work as for Left front with the following exceptions. Use C for the pocket lining & contrast; use E for the 3 sts on pocket edge and place 6/7 buttonholes evenly along the neck edge moss stitches. The buttonholes should be evenly spaced (approx. 3.5" apart), with the first one worked on the 3rd row of ribbing.

Sleeves: With #15 needle & E for left and D for right sleeves, pickup 34/38 sts along the RS of armhole between the bound off stitches of the shaping. Change to #17 needle. Row 1: Purl back, pickup 2 stitches in the 2 bound off stitches at end of row. Row 2: Knit back, pickup 2 stitches in the 2 bound off stitches at end of row. (38/42 sts) Dec 1 st each end every third row down to 18/20 sts. Work 6 rows even or until desired length. Change to #15 needle and work 6 rows in k1, p1 ribbing. Castoff.

Collar: With B pick up stitches for collar, starting at the top of right front button band, up around neck edge, picking up 12 stitches from back neck, down around left neck edge and ending at top of left front neck band. Work in k1,p1 moss stitch for 2 rows. Cast off.

Finishing: Sew up sleeve and side seams. Attach buttons on left front neckband. Attach pocket lining to fronts using slip stitch. Sew in loose ends.
