THE SHAWL THAT STAYS ON

Cascade Yarns Bulky Leisure-10 sks.

#10 1/2 NEEDLES & ST.ST.=3 STS=1"

CAST ON 64 STS. AND KNIT 11 ROWS. NEXT ROW:

1. K6, P52, K6
2. KNIT TO END

REPEAT THESE ROWS UNTIL SHAWL MEASURES 26" ENDING WITH ROW 2.

3. K6, P23, K6, P23, K6
4. KNIT TO END

REPEAT ROWS 3&4 3 TIMES ENDING WITH ROW 4.

5. K6, P23, K3. TURN AND WORK ON THESE 32 STS ONLY
6. KNIT TO END

CONTINUE WORKING ROWS 5&6 FOR 8"

REJOIN YARN TO THE REMAINING 32 STS. AND WORK AS FOLLOWS:

7. K3, P23, K6. WORK ON THESE 32 STS AS FOR THE OTHER SIDE
8. KNIT TO END

KNIT FOR 8".

JOIN BOTH PIECES AND WORK ROWS 3 & 4 AGAIN 3 TIMES.

CONTINUE ON ROWS 1 & 2 FOR 20".

WORK ROWS 3 & 4 AGAIN

THEN ROWS 5&6

THEN ROWS 3 & 4

THEN ROWS 1 & 2

FINISH WITH 11 ROWS OF KNIT AND BIND OFF LOOSELY.

FRINGE: CUT 128 STRANDS OF YARN 30" LONG EACH.

WITH CROCHET HOOK, CONNECT 2 STRANDS AT BOUND OFF EDGE IN EVERY OTHER STITCH. REPEAT FOR CAST ON EDGE.
