



Hooded Magnum Shawl

using
Cascade **MAGNUM** Yarn

Materials:

Cascade Magnum 10 sks.

#17 needles

Cast on 60 sts.

Knit 6 rows.

1. knit.

2. k4, p52, k4.

Repeat rows 1 & 2 for 20".

3. knit.

4. k4, p14, k4, p32, k4.

Repeat 3 & 4 one more time.

5. k20, turn. Put remaining 40 sts on holder for later.

6. k2, p14, k4

Repeat 5 & 6 for 8" and put these 20 sts on holder for later.

Rejoin yarn to the 40 sts you left on holder earlier and work as follows:

7. k2, p32, k4.

8. knit.

Repeat 7 & 8 for 8".

Now working on all 60 sts. work row 3 & 4/ 2 times.

Repeat rows 1 & 2 for 26".

Work rows 3 & 4/ 2 times.

Work rows 5 thru 8.

Now working on all 60 sts. work row 3 & 4 / 2 times.

Work rows 1 & 2 for 20".

Knit 6 rows.

Bind off loosely.

Hood:

Cast on 48 sts.

1. knit.

2. k4, p40, k4.

Repeat rows 1 & 2 for 12". Bind off loosely.

Fold the hood in half and sew 1 edge together from the k4 edge to the center. Find the center of the shawl, sew the hood on to the edge of the shawl that has the 20 sts. worked for the armhole.

Make 4 tassels that are 6" long and attach to each of the 4 corners of the shawl.

Make 1 tassel that measures 4" long and attach to the point of the hood.

Pockets: (make 2)

Cast on 16 sts and knit 30 rows. Bind off loosely and sew pockets to shawl.
