



**Sierra Baby Blanket (B126)
Using Cascade Sierra Pattern**



SIERRA BABY BLANKET (B126)

Finished measurements: 45"X 45"

Materials: Sierra by Cascade Yarns= 7 sk of main color (mc)
2 sk of contrast color (cc)

47: circular needle #11
stitch markers
Crochet hook size H

Abbreviations:

K.....knit
Yo.....yarn over
Tog.....together
Sl1.....slip 1 stitch
Pssso.....pass slipped stitch over

Blanket is worked with 2 strands of Sierra together through out

Using mc, cast on 3 sts.

Increase 1 st and knit to end.

Repeat this row until you have 7 sts.

K3, yo, knit to end.

Repeat this row until you have used 3 sks of mc.

Using 2 strands of cc, continue in pattern for 16 rows. Change to mc and work 8 rows.

Begin decreasing.

K2, k2tog, yo, k2tog knit to end.

Work this row 8 times total. Change to cc and continue in pattern for 16 rows. Change back to mc and continue until you have 3 sts. remaining.

Sl1, k2tog, pssso.

Finishing:

Using 2 strands of cc and crochet hook, chain until you have enough to weave thru eyelets from the starting point (leaving enough for a tie), along 2 sides and leave enough to tie with at the finishing point. Repeat for the other side. Tie bows at both points.
