Size (finished Measurements)

S	M	L
38	42	46

Materials

10(10,12) skeins of Cascade Pearls

#11 Needles

Size J Crochet Hook

Gauge

13 stitches and 14 rows = 4" in stockinette stitch

2 Strands together

Back and Front

With 2 strands held together. Cast on 56(62,68) stitches. Work in stockinette stitch for 2". Increase 1 stitch at each end every 2" 3 times. 62(68,74) stitches.

Continue until work measures 8 1/2"(10",11") from bottom. Begin sleeve shaping

Increase 1 stitch at be of next 6 rows 68(74,80) stitches. Cas on 10 stitches at

beginning of next 2 rows 88(94,100) stitches. Continue until work measures

17 1/2"(19",21") from bottom. Begin neck and shoulder shaping . Bind off 6(7,7)

stitches. Knit 31(33,36) stitches. Keep 32(34,37) stitches on right-hand needle.

Bind off center 12 stitches. Finish row. Turn work.

Bind off 6(7,7) stitches. Work across row. Turn work.

Bind off 3 stitches at neck edge. Finish row. Turn work.

Bind off 6(7,8) stitches. Work across row. Turn work.

Decrease 1 stitch at neck edge. Finish row. Turn work.

Bind off 7(7,8) stitches. Work across row. Turn work. Dec 1 stitch at neck edge.

Finish row. Turn work. Bind off 7(7,8) stitches. Work across row. Turn work.

Work across row. Turn work. Bind off last 7(8,8) stitches.

Complete the other side the same way.

Join yarn at neck edge (on purl side)

Finishing

Sew shoulder and side seams.

Work 1 row single crochet and 1 row crab stitch around neck, armholes and bottom of sweater.
