## DIAMONDS HAT AND SCARF

Materials: Cascade Yarn's Covington (53% Wool/47% Acrylic) - shown in color 03  
2 skeins makes scarf and hat  
Needles size for hat: size 9 -16" circular for ribbing , 10 ½ 16" circular and dpns  
For scarf size 10 ½  
Cable needle, markers  
Yarn needle

Finished Measurements: Hat: 21 ½" approx.  
Scarf: 54"

### Abbreviations:

C3B = Sl next st onto cable needle and hold at back of work, knit next 2 sts from left-handed needle then knit st from cable needle.

C3F = Sl next 2 sts onto cable needle and hold in front of work, knit next st from left-handed needle then knit 2 sts from cable needle.

T3B = Sl next st onto cable needle and hold at back of work, knit next 2 sts from left-handed needle, then purl st from cable needle.

T3F = Sl next 2 sts onto cable needle and hold in front of work, purl next st on left-handed needle, then knit sts on cable needle.

C5B = Sl next 3 sts onto cable needle and hold in back of work, knit next 2 sts on left-handed needle, then knit sts on cable needle.

### Diamond Pattern (13 stitches)

Row 1: (Right side) P3, C3B, P1, C3f, P3.

Row 2: K3, P3, K1, P3, K3.

Row 3: P2, C3B, P1, K1, P1, C3F, P2.

Row 4: K2, P3, K1, P1, K1, P3, K2.

Row 5: P1, C3B, P1, (K1, P1) 2 times, C3F, P1.

Row 6: K1, P3, K1, (P1, K1) 2 times, P3, K1.

Row 7: C3B, P1, (K1, P1) 3 times, C3F.

Row 8: P3, K1, (P1, K1) 3 times, P3.

Row 9: K2, P1, (K1,P1) 4 times, K2.

Row 10: P2, K1, (P1, K1) 4 times, P2.

Row 11: T3F, P1, (K1, P1) 3 times, T3B.

Row 12: K1, P2, K1, (P1, K1) 3 times, P2, K1.

Row 13: P1, T3F, P1, (K1, P1) 2 times, T3B, P1.

Row 14: K2, P2, K1, (P1, K1) 2 times, P2, K2.

Row 15: P2, T3F, P1, K1, P1, T3B, P2.

Row 16: K3, P2, K1, P1, K1, P2, K3.

Row 17: P3, T3F, P1, T3B, P3.

Row 18: K4, P2, K1, P2, K4.

Row 19: P4, C5B, P4.

Row 20: K4, P5, K4.

Repeat rows 1-20 for pattern.

### SCARF

With size 10 ½ needles cast on 21 sts.

Knit 6 rows.

Row 1: K4 for garter stitch border, place marker, work 13 sts of Row 1 of Diamond Pattern, place marker, K4 for other side border.

Continue in patterns as established for 13 pattern repeats ending with row 17.

Knit 6 rows and bind off. Weave in ends. Steam slightly if needed.

## HAT

With size 9 circular needles, cast on 76 sts and work in K1, P1 ribbing for 1 ¼", decrease 1 st on last row to 75 sts.

Change to larger needles.

Row 1: \*P2, work Row 19 of Diamond Pattern\* rep between \*'s around. (5 repeats)

REPLACE ALL EVEN ROWS OF DIAMOND PATTERN WITH: K on the K's and P on the P's as they face you.

Continue in pattern as established. (There will be 2 purl sts between the diamond pattern repeats around.) Work one repeat of Diamond Pattern rows ending with Row 19.

Purl next row decreasing 5 sts evenly around to 70 sts.

Decreasing for Top:

Row 1: \*P5, P2 tog\* rep between \*'s around.

Row 2 and all even rows: Purl.

Row 3: \*P4, P2 tog\* rep between \*'s around.

Row 5: \*P3, P2 tog\* rep between \*'s around.

Continue in this manner until P2 tog around.

Break yarn leaving several inches and with yarn needle run end through the remaining sts. Secure well and weave in ends.

Steam slightly if needed.
