



**Taormina Ribbon Cowl Neck Shell (C167)
Using Cascade Bollicine Taormina Pattern**



Taormina Ribbon Cowl Neck Shell (C167)

Materials: 4 Skeins Cascade Taormina
Size 10.5 and 11 Needles

Gauge: 4 Sts = 1"

Back:

With larger needles cast on 64(68, 72) sts. Work one RS row. Begin Shaping. Dec 1 st each side, every 10th row 2x. Inc 1 st each side, every 10 row 2x. Continue until piece measures 10.5"(11",11.5").

Armhole Shaping:

Bind off 3(5, 5) sts at beg of next 2 rows. Dec 1 st each side every other row 3x(3x, 4x). Cont until piece meas 18.5"(19", 19.5") from beg.

Shoulder Shaping:

Bind off 4 sts beg of next 2 rows. Bind off 5 sts beg of next 2 rows. Bind off 5 st beg of next 2 rows. Bind off 24(26, 26) back neck sts.

Front:

Work as for back including all shaping. At same time, when piece measures 17"(17.5", 18") begin neck shaping. Work to center 8 sts, attach a second ball of yarn. Bind off center 8 sts., complete row. Work both sides at once. Dec 1 st at each neck edge every other row 4x(5x, 5x). Continue until piece measures 18.5"(19", 19") from beg.

Shape Shoulders:

Work shoulder shaping to correspond with back.

Armhole Edging:

Sew sides and shoulders. With smaller needles pick up 70(72, 78) sts around armhole edge. Bind off immediately in purl.

Neck Finishing:

With smaller needles pick up 58(68, 60) sts evenly around neck. Work In reverse stockinette stitch for 8". Bind off loosely.
