



**Pink Cap
Using Cascade Fixation Pattern**



Pink Cap

Size: 15x42cm

Materials: Fixation yarn, 1 ball in pink (3085), and 1 pair of knitting needles with 4,5 mm.

Stitches: purl (p), knit (k), double decrease: take off 1 knit without working it, knit 2 stitches together and cast off the non worked stitch on the worked one; fantasy stitch: 1st, 3rd, and 5th rounds - 1 k, *3 loops, 1 k*, repeating between stars to the end of rounds;

2nd, 4th, and 6th rounds: in purl, releasing all loops from previous round without working them;

7th round: 3 k, *1 double decrease, 6 k*, repeating between stars and finishing round with 3 k.

8th, 10th, 12th, and 14th rounds: in purl;

9th round: 2 k, *1 double decrease, 4 k*, repeating between stars and finishing round with 2 k;

11th round: 1 k, *1 double decrease, 2 k*, repeating between stars and finishing round with 1 k;

13th round: *double decrease* repeating between stars to the end of round.

Instructions:

Using 2 strands of yarn cast on 73 stitches and work in elastic stitch 1/1, following diagram 1. When 2,5 cm from beginning change to fantasy stitch and work until 14th round. Cast off leaving long tail. Thread through tapestry needle and thread through remaining stitches on needle as if to purl, taking stitches off needle. Pull tightly to close the top of hat. Stretch the piece downwards to accommodate loops. Sew sides.

Gauge: a 5 x 5 cm square (using knitting needles with 4,5 mm) = 9 stitches x 10 rows in stocking stitch (right side in knit, wrong side in purl).
