Pure Alpaca Reversible Cable Moebius

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The twist in the moebius shape allows it to sit nicely as a snood or off the shoulder capelet.

2 (3) skeins Pure Alpaca #

size 7 needle, or size necessary to achieve gauge, straight or circular, but with a good point longish cable needle (a size 7 dpn will work well)

darning needle for finishing

Scrap yarn and crochet hook for provisional cast on

Dimensions: 13" wide and 32" long. Directions given for making a wider piece.

Gauge worked k2,p1 on right side, k1,p2 on wrong side: 24sts per 4"

cn – cable needle

m – marker

pm – place marker

Cables: Cables are kept in rib pattern.

9/9LC: slip 9 st to cable needle, hold in front, work next 9 sts of section in rib, work sts from cn in rib

9/9RC: slip 9 st to cable needle, hold in back, work next 9 sts of section in rib, work sts from cn in rib

12/12LC: slip 12 st to cable needle, hold in front, work next 12 sts of section in rib, work sts from cn in rib

12/12RC: slip 12 st to cable needle, hold in back, work next 12 sts of section in rib, work sts from cn in rib

Note: The first stitch of each row is slipped purlwise. This makes a pleasing, elastic edge.

Provisionally cast on 114 sts.

Setup row: with working yarn, p3, pm, *work 18sts. in pattern, pm* repeat between ** once, work pattern on next 36 sts, pm, Repeat ** twice more, p3. This counts as row 1.

The pattern will sit on the needles as follows:

3sts	m	18sts	m	18sts	m	36sts	m	18sts	m	18sts	m	3sts
		A		B		C		D		F		

There are 36 rows in a repeat.

Rows 1, 3, 5,7, 11, 13, 15, 19, 21, 23, 25, 29, 31, 33:

sl1 pwise, p2, *k2, p1* across to last 3 sts,, p3

Even rows:

sl1 pwise, k2, *K1, P2* repeat between *s across to last 3 sts, k3.

Row 9: Section A: 9/9LC, Section C: (k2,p1) twice, 12/12LC, (k2,p1) twice, Section F: 9/9 RC

Rows 17 and 35: Section B: 9/9LC, Section D: 9/9RC

Row 27: Section A 9/9LC, Section C: (k2,p1) twice, 12/12RC, (k2,p1) twice, Section F: 9/9RC

Repeat until desired length, ending with row 22. Keeping live stitches on needle, unzip provisional cast on, taking care to pick up all sts on another needle. Giving piece one twist so that right side meets wrong side, close with Kitchener st. This avoids a seam, making the piece reversible.

To make the moebius wider, add an extra "A" between "B" and "C" and an extra "F" between "C" and "D." It could be even wider by adding an extra "B" and "D" appropriately. The piece could be made longer so that it would fit on the shoulders.
