US 5 (3.75mm) & US - 7
 (4.50mm) 5 x 5/8' Diameter
 Buttons

TENSION:

On # 7 Needles in Stocking Stitch = 26sts = 5", 27 Rows = 4" or size required to give correct tension.

ABBREVIATIONS:

CO = Cast On
 K = Knit
 P = Purl
 SS = Stocking Stitch (knit 1 row, Purl 1 row)
 MC = Main Color
 CC = Contrast Color
 Sts = Stitches
 Beg = Beginning
 RS = Right Side Facing
 YB = Yarn back as though to Purl
 BO = Bind off
 SSK - Slip 1, K1, PSSO or (k2 tog in back of next 2 sts)

INSTRUCTIONS:

BACK

With Smaller Needles & MC, CO 52 (56, 60, 64, 68) Sts.

Rows 1 - 8: K . (Border)

Change to Larger Needles

Row 9 : Purl

Work in SS for 2(2 ½, 3 ½, 4, 4 ½)" from beg, ending with a P Row.

Next Row: CO 4 Stitches K to end & CO 4 Stitches.

Continue in SS for 3 more Rows

Next Row: CHECKS

Row 1: (RS) with CC, k2, (sl2, k2) across, ending with k2

Row 2: K the K sts and sl the sl sts Purl (YB slip stitches purlways, YF knit stitches) as they appear

Row 3 - 4: Repeat Row 1 & 2

Row 5: MC, K

Row 6: MC P

Row 7-10: Repeat Rows 5 & 6,

Row 11: CC, K

Row 12: CC, P

Row 13: MC, K

Row 14: MC, P

Row 15-18: Repeat Rows 11-14

Rows 19-20: Then Rows 11-12 Once

Rows 21 - 26: MC, SS

Row 27-30: ***Then Repeat Rows 1 - 4*** of CHECKS PATTERN

Change to MC until work measures 12 ½(14 ¼, 16, 18, 20)" from Beg.

Bind Off

Right Front

With smaller Needles and MC Cast on 26 (28, 30, 32, 34)Stitch

Rows 1 - 8: K . (Border)

Change to Larger Needles

Row 9 : Purl

Work in SS for 2(2 ½, 3 ½, 4, 4 ½)" from beg, ending with a P Row.

Next Row: CO 4 Stitches K to end. 30(32, 34, 36, 38)

Continue in SS for 3 more Rows

Next Row: CHECKS

Row 1: (RS) with CC, k2, (sl2, k2) across, ending with k2

Row 2: K the K sts and sl the sl sts Purl (YB slip stitches purlways, YF knit stitches) as they appear

Row 3 - 4: Repeat Row 1 & 2

Row 5: MC, K

Row 6: MC P

Row 7-10: Repeat Rows 5 & 6,

Row 11: CC, K

Row 12: CC, P

Row 13: MC, K

Row 14: MC, P

Row 15-18: Repeat Rows 11-14

Rows 19-20: Then Rows 11-12 Once

Rows 21 - 26: MC, SS

Row 27-30: ***Repeat Rows 1 - 4*** Of CHECKS Pattern

Change to MC

Work 2 rows.

Shape Neck edge as follows

Work in SS, Decrease at neck edge on Next and every 2nd Row until 21(25, 27,29,31) sts remain.

Continue in SS until 12 ½(14 ¼, 16, 18, 20)" from Beg

Bind Off

Left Front

Work as Right front reversing the 4 stitch increase at vent and the decreasing at neck edge.

DECREASE METHOD: **Left Side:** knit to last 3 stitches, SSK, k1

Sleeves (Make 2)

With Smaller needles and MC, CO 30,(30, 34, 34, 34,) sts. K8 rows.
Change to Larger needles and P across

Next Row: K, Increase 1 st each end or this row 32 (32, 36, 36, 36) sts.

Next Row: P

Next Row: CHECKS

Row 1: (Rs) with CC, k2, (st2, k2) across, ending with k2

Row 2: K the K sts and sl the sl sts Purl ways (by YB Slip 2 purlways, YO K 2) as they appear

Row 3 - 4: Repeat Row 1 & 2

Row 5: MC, K

Row 6: MC P

Row 7-10: Rep rows 5-6.

Rep rows 1-10 of Checks, AT THE SAME TIME, include new sts into pat as they accumulate, Inc 1 st each edge of every 4th row to 52 (56, 62, 66, 68,). Work even to 6 ½ (8, 9, 9 ½, 10) inches from beg, ending with a MC Purl Row. Bind Off

FINISHING

Join shoulder seams. Place markers 5(5 ½, 6, 6 ¼, 6 ½) from shoulder seam along each side edge. Set in sleeves between markers. Join underarm and side seams.

Side Vents (Make four) With the RS facing using smaller needles and MC, pick up and K9(11, 16, 18, 20) sts evenly spaced along vent opening. K8 Rows. Bind Off loosely. Join to top of vent.

Left Front border: Place a marker at center of back neck. With the RS facing, using smaller needles and MC, pick up and K 11(13, 14, 14, 15) sts evenly to shoulder, 25 (27, 30, 32, 35) sts evenly spaced to top of Body Pattern, 40(43, 48, 51, 54) sts evenly spaced to lower edge. K3 Rows.

Buttonhole Row: K36(43, 47, 47, 54) , [yo,,k2tog, k6(6, 7, 8, 8) sts,] Repeat [to] 4 more times (5 button holes.)

K4 more rows. BO loosely and knit wise.

Right Front Border: Work as for Left Border omitting buttonholes.

Join back neck seam. Sew buttons opposite button holes.

ALTERNATIVE BAND:

With smaller needles start at the bottom of the left front (with needle in left hand) pick up **40 (43, 48, 51, 54) sts evenly spaced to lower left edge, 25 (27, 30, 32, 35) sts evenly spaced to top of Body Pattern, K 22(26, 28, 28, 30) sts evenly from shoulder to shoulder, 25 (27, 30, 32, 35) sts evenly spaced to top of Body Pattern on the right side, 40(43, 48, 51, 54) sts evenly spaced to lower edge right side.**

Row 1-3: Purl all rows

Row 4:Purl 6 sts, , [yo,,P2tog, k6(6, 7, 8, 8) sts,] Repeat [to] 4 more times (5 button holes.)

Row 5-8: Purl

Bind off Knitways
