MATERIALS USED

**Cascade Yarns Cherub Aran
- 100G (240 yds) 55% Nylon,
45% Acrylic
Markers = 6**

**US 5DPN or Circular Needles (3.75mm) & US - 7 DPN or circular needles (4.50mm) 5 x 5/8' Diameter
Buttons (I use 2 curcular needles)**

Advanced Knitter

TENSION:

On # 7 Needles in Stocking Stitch = 26sts = 5", 27 Rows = 4" or size required to give correct tension.

Knitted in one piece to armholes after the bottom bands have been worked.

ABBREVIATIONS:

CO = Cast On

K = Knit

P = Purl

SS = Stocking Stitch (knit 1 row, Purl 1 row)

MC = Main Color

Sts = Stitches

Beg = Beginning

RS = Right Side Facing

Inc = Knit into the back and the front of the next stitch

BO = Bind off

SSK: K2tog in back of stitch.

CABLE: Knit into the back of the second stitch and then into the front of the first stitch. Take both off left needle together.

BUTTON HOLE: Work button holes evenly along left or right front to the beginning of the decrease as follows: : **K1, P1, * Cable, P1, YO, SSK, pattern to end.**

INSTRUCTIONS:

LEFT FRONT:

With Smaller Needles CO 37(39, 41, 43, 45) Sts.

Row 1: Purl turn

Row 2: **K1, P1 *Cable, P1*** repeat from * to * **K1, turn**

Row 3: Purl, turn

Repeat rows 2 & 3, 3 more times

Row 10: **K1, P1, *Cable, P1*** Repeat from * to * 1 more time, (2 Cables) Knit to end of row. , turn

Row 11: Purl, turn

Hold stitches on needle.

BACK

With Smaller Needles CO 52 (56, 60, 64, 68) Sts.

Rows 1: Purl, turn

Row 2: **K1, P1, *Cable, P1*** repeat from to end **K1, turn**

Row 3: Purl, turn

Repeat rows 2 & 3, 3 more times

Row 10 : Knit, turn

Row 11:Purl, turn

Hold stitches on needle.

RIGHT FRONT:

With Smaller Needles CO 37 (39, 41, 43, 45) Sts.

Row 1: Purl, turn

Row 2: **K1, P1, *Cable, P1*** repeat from * to * **K1, turn**

Row 3: Purl, turn

Repeat rows 2 & 3, 3 more times, turn

Row 10: Knit to last 8 Stitches, **P1, *Cable, P1*** Repeat from * to * 1 more times, **K1. , turn**

Row 11: Purl, turn

Hold stitches on needle.

Change to Larger Needles a circular needle is best used here, however you are knitting back and forth.

Left Front, Back & Right Front

(Make sure you have all pieces with RS facing you as you are joining the LF, Back & RF together)

Row 12: K1, P1,* Cable, P1*,Repeat from * to * once, K8, P1, repeat from * to* 3 times K74 (82, 90, 98, 106) *P1, ** Cable, P1Repeat from ** to ** 3 times, K8, P1, Repeat from * to * 2 times, K1, turn (You will have 2 cable pattern for band and 3cable patterns on each front)**

Row13 : Purl

Row 14: K1, P1,* Cable, P1*,Repeat from * to * once, K8, P1, repeat from * to* 3 times K74 (82, 90, 98, 106) P1, Repeat from * to * 3 times, K8, P1, Repeat from * to * 2 time K1, turn

Row 15: Purl

Repeat Rows 14 & 15 until work measures 6 ½(8, 9, 9 ½, 10) Shorten or lengthen here 37 (39, 41, 43, 45) Sts.

DIVIDE FOR LEFT FRONT

LEFT FRONT: RS

Next Row: K1, P1,* Cable, P1*,Repeat from * to * once, K8, P1, repeat from * to* 3 times, K11, (13,15, 17,19) turn

Next Row: Purl

Decrease at next edge next and alt rows 7 times while keeping band pattern correct.

K1, P1,* Cable, P1*,Repeat from * to * once, SSK, K to next cable group, P1, *Cable, P1* 3 times, K11, (13,15, 17,19) turn

Repeat Last 2 Rows 6 times (gives you 7 decreases and 29(30 32, 34, 36,38)

Continue on these stitches keeping cable band correct until work measures 12 ½(14 ¼, 15, 16, 18)'' from Beg.

Bind Off

Back:

Knit up 52 (56, 60, 64, 68) Sts.

Work in SS until work measures 12 ½(14 ¼, 15, 16, 18)'' from Beg.

Bind Off

Right Front

As for Left Front Reversing Decreases by K2 tog at band front

Next Row: CHECKS

Row 1: (RS) with CC, k2, (sl2, k2) across, ending with k2

Row 2: K the K sts and sl the sl sts Purl (YB slip stitches purlways, YF knit stitches) as they appear

Row 3 - 4: Repeat Row 1 & 2

Row 5: MC, K

Row 6: MC P

Row 7-10: Repeat Rows 5 & 6,

Row 11: CC, K

Row 12: CC, P

Row 13: MC, K

Sleeves (Make 2)

With Smaller needles DPN or Circular and CO 30,(30, 34, 34, 34,) sts. Place Marker at beginning of row. Slip Marker at the end of each row.

Row 1: Knit, Slip marker

Row 2: K1, P1 *Cable, P1* repeat from * to * end

Row 3: Knit

Repeat rows 2 & 3, 4 more times

Row 11: K2,* Inc., knit to last 3 stitches, Inc., K2*, 40(40, 42, 42, 42) sts

****INCREASE,**: K2, Inc., knit to last 2 stitches Inc., K2.****

Change to Larger needles and Knit all rows * increasing*** every 4th row until 60(60, 64, 64, 64) stitches**

Next Rows: Knit until work measures 7 (7 1/2, 8, 8 1/2, 9)Inches

Bind Off

FINISHING

Join shoulder seams.

Sew in Sleeve fitting it to the armhole.

Sew on buttons matching them to the buttonholes
