AUTUMN-WINTER 2006-2007
GREEN PULL WITH MIMOSA PATT AND CABLES
Size 8/10 (12/14)
Medium difficulty

MATERIALS

• 400 (450) g Madil Yarn **Fusion** green no. 707 • knitting needles size 8 US/ 5 1/2 mm • cable needle (cn).

STITCHES USED

• **with knitting needles:** • 2/2 rib • seed st • rightwise cable (over 10 sts): **Rows 1, 3, 5, 9 and 11:** p 2, k 6, p 2; **Row 2 and all even rows:** work sts as they face you; **Row 7:** p 2, cross 6 rightwise (slip 3 sts onto cn and hold in back of work, k 3 then k 3 from cn), p 2; **Row 13:** rep from Row 1 • **leftwise cable:** (over 10 sts): **Rows 1, 3, 5, 9 and 11:** p 2, k 6, p 2; **Row 2 and all even rows:** work sts as they face you; **Row 7:** p 2, cross 6 leftwise (slip 3 sts onto cn and hold in front of work, k 3 then k 3 from cn), p 2; **Row 13:** rep from Row 1 • **mimosa patt** (multiple of 5 sts): **Row 1:** * k 4 tog, work 4 sts in 1 [in the same st work: (k 1, p 1) twice] *, rep from * to *; **Row 2 and all even rows:** k; **Row 3:** * work 4 sts in 1, k 4 tog *, rep from * to *; **Row 5:** rep from Row 1.

GAUGES

10 cm square over seed st = 13 sts and 16 rows.

10 cm square over mimosa patt = 13 sts and 15 rows.

The 10 rightwise and leftwise cable sts = 6.5 cm.

WORKING INSTRUCTIONS

Back: with larger needles cast on 54 (56) sts and work border in 2/2 rib for 8 rows (4 cm). Cont in seed st. At 37 (39) cm from border, equal to 60 (62) rows, to shape armholes bind off each side, every other row, 3 sts once, 1 st twice. At 18 (20) cm from beg of armholes, equal to 30 (32) rows, bind off rem 44 sts.

Front: with larger needles cast on 54 (56) sts and work border as for back. Now set work as foll: 6 (7) seed sts, 10-st rightwise cable, inc 3 sts evenly spaced across center 22 sts work 25 sts in mimosa patt (inc as foll: across the 1st row of patt k 3 tog 3 times instead of k 4 tog of patt), 10-st leftwise cable, 6 (7) seed sts. At 37 (39) cm from border measured on the seed st part, equal to 60 (62) rows, to shape armholes bind off each side, every other row, 3 sts once, 1 st twice. At 13 (15) cm from beg of armholes, equal to 20 (22) rows, to shape neckline slip center 9 sts on a holder and cont each part separately letting stand another 3 sts towards center after 2 rows. At 5 cm from beg of neckline (8 rows) bind off rem 16 (17) shoulder sts.

Sleeves: with larger needles cast on 30 (32) sts and work border in 2/2 rib for 18 rows (11 cm) inc 7 sts evenly spaced across the last row. Cont in mimosa patt allowing 1 selvedge st on both sides (1 selvedge st, k 1). Each side, within selvedge st, inc every 6 rows 1 st 4 times, every 4 rows 1 st 6 times, every other row 1 st twice (make 1: with the LH needle lift running thread between 2 sts and k through back loop) and cont mimosa patt over increased sts as soon as possible. At 40 (43) cm from border, equal to 60 (64) rows, k 2 rows then bind off.

FINISHING

Join one shoulder seam. With smaller needles knit up 46 sts around the neckline (k standing sts). Work collar in 2/2 rib for 25 rows (start with k 2 on WS for work) then p 2 rows binding off in the last row. Join the sides of collar from top halfway down on the RS, then on the WS. Join the other shoulder and side seams. Sew and mount sleeves easing the sts of the last row along armhole edges.
