## Cascade Pima Tencel Berry Beret

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**YARN:** Cascade Yarns Pima Tencel 50% Peruvian Pima Cotton 50% Tencel #9201

**AMOUNT:** 2 skeins

**NEEDLE:** US5 (3.75mm). Band is worked back and forth and can be done on straight or circular needle. Hat body is knit in the round using method of your choice (16" round, DPN's or magic loop. Choose needle length based on your preference.)

**GAUGE:** 20 sts / 4 inches or 10 cms in stockinette stitch.

**SIZE:** Adult Med 20-22" head circumference

**SKILL:** Intermediate (basic stitches and shaping, Knit in the round, bobble stitch and cable or knitted cast-on)

### SPECIAL STITCHES

**Make Bobble (MB)** (K1, YO, K1, YO, K1) in 1 st, making 5 sts from 1 st; turn and K5; turn and P5; turn and K1, SL1, K2tog, PSSO, K1; turn P3tog.

Hat begins with band cast on widthwise and worked back and forth with berry tassels formed at ends of each row. Band is then joined to work in round.

### BERRY BERET INSTRUCTIONS

#### Berry Band

Note: hat band requires cast-on at end of row already worked. You can use knitted, cable cast-on or backward loop method.

Cast on 92. (Any preferred method.)

**Row 1:** MB, BO9, K to end, CO10, turn.

**Row 2:** MB, BO9, K to end, CO13, turn.

**Row 3:** MB, BO12, K to end, CO13, turn.

**Row 4:** MB, BO12, K to end, CO10, turn.

**Row 5:** MB, BO9, K to end, turn (84)

**Row 6:** Knit. Join to work in round. PM to mark beg of round.

#### Beret Body Increase

**Rows 1-2: Knit. (84)**

**Row 3:** \*K2, YO; rep from \* to end. (126)

**Row 4:** \*K2, KTBL; rep from \* to end. (126)

Work even until piece measures 4" from cast on edge.

#### Beret Body Decrease

**Row 1:** \*K19, P2tog; rep from\* to end. (120)

**Even Rows 2-24:** Knit.

**Row 3:** \*K18, P2tog; rep from\* to end. (114)

**Row 5:** \*K17, P2tog; rep from\* to end. (108)

**Row 7:** \*K16, P2tog; rep from\* to end. (102)

**Row 9:** \*K15, P2tog; rep from\* to end. (96)  
**Row 11:** \*K14, P2tog; rep from\* to end. (90)  
**Row 13:** \*K13, P2tog; rep from\* to end. (84)  
**Row 15:** \*K12, P2tog; rep from\* to end. (78)  
**Row 17:** \*K11, P2tog; rep from\* to end. (66)  
**Row 15:** \*K10, P2tog; rep from\* to end. (60)  
**Row 17:** \*K9, P2tog; rep from\* to end. (54)  
**Row 19:** \*K8, P2tog; rep from\* to end. (48)  
**Row 21:** \*K7, P2tog; rep from\* to end. (42)  
**Row 23:** \*K6, P2tog; rep from\* to end. (36)  
**Row 25:** \*K5, P2tog; rep from\* to end. (30)  
**Row 26:** \*K4, P2tog; rep from\* to end. (24)  
**Row 27:** \*K3, P2tog; rep from\* to end. (18)  
**Row 28:** \*K2, P2tog; rep from\* to end. (12)  
**Row 29:** \*K1, P2tog; rep from\* to end. (6)  
**Row 30:** \*K2tog; rep from \* to end. (3).

Break yarn and draw through 3 loops, snug up, pull through to reverse side and secure.  
Weave in ends. Block and enjoy!
